

## **Mounting Your Zero Gravity Windscreen**

Remove both the mirror fasteners located under each mirror. Remove both mirrors. Remove the 6 screws holding the windscreen in place. Remove the windscreen by pulling to the rear. Remove the 4 rear Well Nut fasteners from the factory windscreen and insert them into the 4 rear holes of your Zero Gravity windscreen. If the original fasteners are unusable or bulged to the point where they cannot be re-inserted into your new windscreen, use new Well Nut fasteners. For 2013 and newer models, the two forward holes in the factory windscreen will have plastic inserts. Do not attempt to remove them and insert them into your Zero Gravity windscreen. Your Zero Gravity windscreen is designed to function without inserts in the front two holes. To install your new windscreen, insert it between the inner and outer fairing layers exactly as the factory windscreen had been installed. Insert the 6 screws and tighten them snugly being very careful not to over-tighten.
